GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER (Optional):

- How do you typically choose between several options when making a decision?
- Who do you turn to for solid guidance when you need direction?

BREAKING THE ICE:

- What are the first three words that come to mind when you think about God right now? Why?
- What about Jesus? Do any different words come to mind when you think of Him?

GO TO THE SOURCE: John 14:26; John 16:7 (ESV)

DIG A LITTLE DEEPER:

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS YOUR HELPER (Visitation and Habitation)

Read John 14:15-26 and answer the following questions:

- Who is the Holy Spirit? What does the Holy Spirit do (Compare with John 14:26, 15:26, and 16:10)?

- Why must we not think of the Holy Spirit as a power or a force?
- How is the Holy Spirit our “helper” (v. 16)?
- How does verse 18 speak to our identity as God's children? What does it tell us about how we should view God?
- What tools does the Holy Spirit use to guide us? How do we tap into His guidance?

THE HOLY SPIRIT INTERPRETS, EMPOWERS, AND COMFORTS

Read John 16:6-8 and answer the following questions:

- In what ways does the Spirit help us in our walk with Christ?
- What is the ministry of the Holy Spirit?
- What is the third aspect of the Holy Spirit's ministry? What role does that aspect play in our responsibility to share the Gospel with others? See Acts 16:14.

THE HOLY SPIRIT FIGHTS YOUR BATTLES

- As Christians, what battles can we expect to face? Read John 16:33.
- What does it mean that the Holy Spirit is our interpreter? Read 1 Corinthians 2:12
- How does the Holy Spirit empower and help us fight our battles? Read Ephesians 6:10-17.
- How does the Holy Spirit provide comfort to the people of God?

MAKE IT COUNT

Help your group identify how the truths from the Scripture passage apply directly to their lives.

- How might reminding yourself that the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, change how you approach your walk with Christ?
- What is one area of your life in which you need to rely on the power of the Spirit to help you glorify God? How might relying on the Spirit's power help you overcome feelings of inadequacy?
- What is a sin issue you have been struggling with lately? What are some practical steps you might take this week to put that sin to death?

PRAYER

- During a time of group prayer, ask the Holy Spirit to be our counselor and help us live lives that glorify Christ.
- Pray that He will convict people of their sins and show them salvation in Jesus. Ask Him to bring comfort and peace to those who are suffering.
- Praise God for transforming us through the death of Christ. Thank Him for sending the Holy Spirit so that we can have a guide and an advocate to help us live lives that glorify God.
