Accessing School:

- Students will access the school through the Main Entrance.
 - School doors will open for students at 7:30AM
 - Breakfast will be provided from 7:30AM - 8:15AM

Driving / Drop Off / Walking:

Visible personnel in Yellow Construction Vests as well as officers from the Stoneham Police Department will be present to direct vehicles for parking and student drop off. A digital display will also be visible as you drive up the driveway to communicate driving / parking instructions as described below.

- **Student Parking:** All student parking is in the lower lot. Parking attendants will direct students to spaces
- **Drop Off:** Drop off route is along the lower parking lot as in the past year and then coming back up towards the school. Student drop off may occur at any spot along the walkway on your right.
- **Bikes / EV bikes / scooters:** Rules of the road apply, pedestrians have right of way on walkways. Do not ride on any landscaped areas
- **Walking:** Stay on identified cement walkways. Grass and other landscaped areas are roped off.

As always please utilize patience, caution and awareness, follow posted signage and do not exceed driving speeds of 5 - 10 MPH when driving on school grounds.
