We usually have a quiz every Friday in my class. This quiz will be a combination of vocabulary and what we have been working on that week. You have the opportunity to receive extra credit (10 points) by making vocabulary flashcards.

You will have one NoRedInk assignment each week to be done outside of class. This will be your only homework assignment unless discipline problems occur.

You will have at least 2 test grades each 6 weeks. This will be a DMAC (EOC testing style) test, and an essay.

**Late Work:**

The late work policy is in place to emphasize the importance of time management. I advise all students to use a planner to help them organize class work and extracurricular activities.

Late assignments receive the following penalties:  
*10 points deducted per day until the assignment is turned in.*

**Makeup Work:**

Students may turn in work due the day of the absence upon their return. Students are given two (2) full weekdays after returning to class to turn in missed work. Late assignments will receive the penalties listed above. If possible, please notify the teacher of extended absences, so accommodations can be made.

I write all the assignments and daily activities on a weekly calendar on the white board each week. If you are absent you are responsible for coming to me to get the missing work.

**I do not give extra credit assignments or extra work because you are failing the regular work.**
