Dear X,

I understand that our union the PSC will be voting on a resolution this Thursday that, among other things, follows the call of student encampment activists in demanding CUNY divest from Israeli companies and boycott Israeli institutions. Well over 40,000 Palestinians have been murdered by the Israeli state, including 15,000 children, and every single university in Gaza has been destroyed along with vital infrastructure, property, and land. At such a time, our union cannot afford to make the wrong decision. If CUNY is profiting from financial and academic agreements with Israel, we are complicit in genocide.

Voting yes on Thursday's resolution will help me, a union member, feel more confident that the union has my back. We've seen from the violent police repression of student protests that the city and state are not on our side; in response, we must not shy away from strong statements upholding the students' actions and demands, and we must work together to fight for a stronger contract that isn't dipped in blood. As the brave students of the encampment have shown us, our students are on the right side of history and we should be too.
