

# **Class Culture Expectations**

## **Must have materials:**

- Pencil/Pen

- Phone
- Chromebook (unless authorized)

- Food
  - **WHY:** These items, while useful elsewhere, can be distracting in class and take away from our main focus of learning about Jesus and strengthening our relationship with God.

## **Classroom culture**

- Stay focused and attentive, avoiding distractions.
- Allow the teacher to speak without interruption.
  - You can always raise your hand if you have a question, or raise/cross your fingers if you need to use the bathroom
- Politely ask before you get water, go to the restroom or get up to do anything
  - Only one person at the restroom or getting water at a time
- Do not crumble, rip or destroy school supplies of any kind (Especially into little pieces)
- Remain awake and engaged during class
- No arguing
  - If there is an issue with someone or with the teacher in class, resolve disagreements calmly and respectfully, and if needed, discuss any issues with the teacher after class.
  - If you prefer, you can also speak with school administration for further assistance.
- Always treat each everyone with kindness and respect.
