

ACT Preparation Sessions

Area students who are preparing to take the ACT are invited to attend test preparation sessions in both October and February at Liberty-Benton High School. Each night there will be sessions from 7:00-8:10 and 8:20-9:30 pm. English, Reading, Mathematics, and Science will be presented during each session. Each student attending will be able to choose the sessions s/he wishes to attend. Watch my website for information closer to the dates.

There is no charge for students to attend this program. The seven local Hancock County Schools, Findlay City Schools and Riverdale underwrite the cost of the program.

Pre-registration is not required. Students are encouraged to attend the sessions most likely to help improve their ACT scores.

Teachers from Findlay City and Hancock County local schools will be reviewing the material and giving students study strategies and test taking tips that will be helpful when taking the test. Students will choose two subjects to review on the first night and can then attend the remaining two subjects on the second night. Students choose which subject sessions to attend each night.

Students should enter the building through the main high school entrance with “Liberty-Benton High School” displayed overhead. Participants are asked to bring a pen or pencil and their copies of the ACT practice booklet with them as well as some notebook or scratch paper. Additional copies of the practice booklet will be available.
