FY26 Budget – Michael Concessi was present to highlight some items.

Since the last budget discussion, no significant changes. Michael went over the highlights again and showed the board the projected tax rate.

Principals would like to discuss bringing the Humanities position back to Twinfield. Michael showed the tax impact for that.

Adding the Humanities position is about the same cost as the summer program that is already built in the budget.

Stephanie spoke on the Humanities position. It was in this current year's budget but the school was not able to fill it. Based on student figures for next year, there is a need for the position.

Thoughts on removing the summer program from the budget and putting it on its own article to be voted on at town meeting day.

A **motion** to approve the FY26 expenditure budget of \$8,225,557 that includes the humanities teacher position and have \$104k for the summer program on a separate article by Erin Barry and seconded by Janna Osman. Motion passed.

Michael will share with the board the 3-year budget comparisons and the examples.

Summer program information will be gathered and shared at the next meeting.

Board discussion on where to share and compile the questions.

Will meet next week to approve and sign the warning.
