

Artist's Terms of Service

Current Edition: 2023

Rules and Conditions for commissioning work from the artist, PricklePants.

This form ideally should be read before commissioning the artist, currently known as PricklePants; It is meant as a guideline for any future and present commissioners to answer questions and “make plain” the rules agreed upon by both parties when requesting a piece made by the artist. Failure to acknowledge these rules can lead to an expulsion from all future projects and your case being dropped.

The artist, PricklePants, is not on a “first come, first serve” basis unless otherwise stated; and will contact you, the client, further if selected for the work.

Because of high volume demand, the artist cannot contact everyone. If you have not been contacted after requesting a piece, you have either failed to put in sufficient contact info or have not been chosen. If not chosen at this time, you may try again at the next scheduled opening unless you have been blacklisted or stated otherwise.

Please note the artist has every right to refuse service without explanation.

Unique Practices

These are unique practices to the artist and should be considered when commissioning the artist (PricklePants). If all else in this document is ignored, this one should not be; These rules can be what either makes or breaks your request being considered. Although not strict, this section will go over details to add to your inquiry that can immensely help your submission push through to acceptance.

Please note that most artists work through compatibility, if your idea is not compatible with the artist, they may not be the right fit for you. It is best to find an artist that fits both your aesthetic and budget.

Reference Sheets

I do not usually take requests from those that do not have reference sheets. There are free ones all over the internet and I even accept “shitty” MS Paint drawings. I am a visual learner so detailed descriptions are not accepted.

Color and Patterns

Whether it is due to lighting changes in the scene drawn or other technical problems. I cannot guarantee that color and patterns are going to match the reference image. *Please do not request a piece from me if you are not okay with this.*

Species

The world is full of vast creatures! I like to pick someone who will allow me to go off-model with their reference sheet in order to make their character better represent their unique species. You picked that species for a reason, I want to see it shine! (ie. I want to draw an Australian Shepard, not a “dog”). Likewise, I am often turned off by characters that are generic titles such as “Cat”.

Ease of Access

I work much better with people who are open to answering questions if I have any! (ie, I work best through social media DMs). Equally, I do not work with those who attempt to invade my privacy by adding me (without my consent) to Discord and watching my status’s change.

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Time Frames/ETAs

I do not usually give out timeframes or ETAs and I have trouble keeping an updated Queue system, sorry. *If you need something done under a specific time frame, I am not the artist for you.*

Body Types

Please for the Love of God! I do not enjoy having customers walk away unhappy with their piece because the build of the character is not to their liking!

Unfortunately, I suffer from the “Disney” syndrome; I will overthink it and draw generic masculine and feminine body types for your character unless you state otherwise. If you need to send me a reference image of their body type, please do so!

Disney: We need to make sure that people will understand which wolf is male and which is female
Disney: OK done



Willfully Difficult

Hi! I have to add this note because of the one person who did this. If you are intentionally withholding relevant information in order to be coy or to play some little game. I’m sorry, please go play games with someone else. Your case will be dropped and you will be blacklisted from future commission inquiries, thank you.

I do not enjoy giving commissioners a bad product on purpose, thank you.

Private Commissions

I do not at this time do private commissions.

Acceptable Requests and Non

This is a list of topics, content, and themes that the artist has set into guidelines of content they are willing to draw. All artists are unique in what they are comfortable and will tolerate drawing, please be mindful of that when putting in your request. Shaming, belittling, and general rudeness regarding this list are not tolerated by the artist and will lead to blacklisting.

Before requesting a piece from the artist, please make sure that you are familiar with the items set on this list before submitting a claim. It saves both the artist's time and saves you, the client, from automatic expulsion. If the content that you are attempting to request is not shown below, please feel free to contact the artist.

Please be aware that although some of these are on a “will draw” list, some complex ideas may cost extra for complexity or come with some stipulations, they will be marked with a * above.

Under no conditions will the artist draw anything from this list, refusal to accept that will lead to automatic blacklisting. Please note, that any exceptions to the items on the list above were done in jest and will not often be repeated.

Other's Characters

When requesting a commission containing another party member's character. It is the Client's responsibility to get the permission of the other person's involved. If the artist senses foul play, the owner of said character may be contacted to validate the claim. If found to be without their permission, this action can lead to expulsion and legal action. Please be aware that most copyright characters will also be passed on.

Other Styles

The artist will blacklist any requests to draw a piece in another artist's style; However, attempting emulation of copyrighted styles (such as My Little Pony, Carebear, etc) can be discussed but the artist is not responsible for the satisfaction of the end product. Due to the complexity, it is advised not to request this.

Paying for an Art Piece

Payment is usually done through paypal invoice or Artist's instructed donation websites. Do not attempt to bypass these rules, sending money may lead to an interpretation of donated funds. Sending funds before submitting a request does not insure a spot on the Artist's queue, nor does giving money to the artist increase your chances of being accepted.

You will be contacted via Private Message (DM) once accepted.

Patrons

Patrons/Subscribers get Early Access when commission slots open and thus can take all allotted slots if there is enough demand. On Top of that, they also receive Exclusive perks like Free or discounted Alt. Pics. If you are a Patron/Subscriber, please send proof of your latest paid tier to discuss perks with the Artist.

A condensed version of this agreement can be found in my Paypal Terms and Conditions, but this is the full version.

Legal Terms and Conditions

By paying the Artist, you are acknowledging that you both comprehend and agree to the rules and guidelines set forth below (Terms of Service). Blatant disregard to these rules can, and will, lead to legal action and a blacklisting of all further work.

- All payments must be made in USD, no exceptions.
- You, the customer, must be of legal age (18+) in your country.
- You, the customer, must own the character that is being requested drawn (unless stated in the previous chapter).
- The commissioned piece may not be uploaded by parties outside the customer and the artist. If found, the piece will be flagged for removal.
- Any art by the Illustrator may not be resold individually or used in cryptocurrency.
- All prices are based on time and amount of work put in. prices are justified and final.
- Invoices must be paid by the date provided. Failure to pay on time must be discussed further with the Artist and could potentially lead to a dropping of the request.
- Commissioned pieces can be used by the Artist for future advertisement and promotional material.
- Sketches are not to be publicly posted or reused unless otherwise stated; if found, they will be flagged for removal and blacklisting from future commissions can occur.

Refunds:

- Refunds must be discussed between the customer and artist before processing.
- If you, the customer, ask for a refund before a sketch is created, you will be refunded the full amount; any work after the sketch phase, the refund price will be reduced for cost of labor.
- Refunds cannot be made after completion of the piece. Refunds may only be made if the piece was never deemed completed by the artist (not the customer).
- Attempts to refund after the completion of the art will cause you, the customer, to be blacklisted and the item will be ticketed.
