- 2- Effective and Efficient risk management programs lead to knowledge and control of risks facing the organizations. The risk management process involves **Identification** of risks and associated potential costs, **Analysis** of the causes of risk of financial loss, determination of various strategies to **Treat** risk,
- 1- selection of strategies appropriate to the goals and objectives of the business,
- 2- Implementation of the selected strategies,
- 3- Monitoring of results.

Resilient organizations are Adjusting and adapting to external and internal forces, and crisis or disaster management are incorporated in the corporate risk management process. An effective risk management program will achieve objectives, reduce losses, and improve financial performance and employee morale.




