- 2.) Motivation- After losing the game, Laura was more motivated to work harder.
- 3.) Conflict- Samantha avoided conflict between Bob and Jill.
- 4.) Loyalty- The dog was loyal to its owner.
- 5.) Protagonist- The girl was dangling off the fire escape when a man saved her from falling, making him a protagonist.
- 6.) Antagonist- Carol was nervous for her volleyball game against her biggest antagonist.
- 7.) Flat character- Throughout the school year, Bella stuck with the same friend group making her a flat character.
- 8.) Round character- Jimmy used to be popular in school until he found out that his mother didn't have long to live. Therefore, he dropped out of school and became lonely which makes him a round character.
