

International charity fundraiser to purchase and deliver medical supplies and foodstuff to hospitals in Zhytomyr, Ukraine

Who are we?

We are a growing and well-organized group of volunteers securing the transport of medical supplies and staples to places in Ukraine impacted by the war, where NGOs face their limits and where their aid cannot reach, and subsequent transport of women and children from these areas to the Polish border, from where coordinated transfer either to the Czech Republic, Poland, or other countries is organized.

Any sum helps and we are very grateful for it!

Whom are we helping?

We collaborate closely with Olha Stakhirska and Viktor Nahornyi, who – in their free time before and after their work and together with other volunteers from Zhytomyr – secure the distribution of foodstuff and lacking medical supplies and drugs to the sick and wounded directly to the local regional hospital, army hospital, and maternity hospitals, of which one was damaged during shelling and was evacuated but is now operating again. Help is also provided to individuals in need (such as large families, families of refugees, especially from the heavily bombed town of Irpin, people with disabilities, etc.) and women and children from the region of Kyiv and Zhytomyr on their way to safety.

What will the funds from this charity fundraiser be used for?

Funds raised will mostly be used to buy medical supplies and foodstuff and for delivery of the aforementioned to Zhytomyr.
