Course Overview

Placement Requirements

Must have a PK-12 clinical school setting and a committed group of adult colleague participants with whom to carry out a planned action research project. Action research projects typically consist of 5-7 professional development sessions with adult colleagues and ongoing implementation with PK-12 students.

Course Objectives

- 1. Students will review and finalize their plan for action research.
- 2. Students will implement their action research activities.
- 3. Students will reflect on their own learning and those of their peers.
- 4. Students will complete written documentation of their action research.
- 5. Students will present their action research.
