- 4. <u>Business operator</u>: An individual who is the on-site manager of a business operating within the neighborhood.

- <u>SeeClickFix</u> Report city issues like invasive weed species, encampment litter, potholes, stormwater issues, graffiti, non-working street lights.
- Smell fumes? see smoke? This includes operations from industrial operations in our neighborhood. Northwest Clean Air Agency
- Report beach-related issues (debris, abandoned boats, invasive species, etc.) and see tide tables through MyCoast via computer or app.
- Noise from aircraft overhead? Learn more and fill out a form to submit a <u>Aircraft</u> <u>Complaint Tracking Form</u>.
- This <u>FAA Aviation Noise Complaint and Inquiry Response</u> form serves as a central hub for the public to submit their concerns and inquiries related to aircraft noise.
- Aircraft should be more than 1000 ft. above ground. https://www.flightradar24.com/
