

- <u>FreeDigitalPhotos</u> offers both free & paid versions of images where the free versions are limited in size and require a link back to the photographer. Photos are categorized in detail & no registration is required.
- Although <u>FreePixels</u> isn't the biggest website, almost every photo included is high quality & beautiful.

- <u>Stockvault</u> is a stock photo-sharing website where photographers can upload any number of images & others can use them for free.
- Historical Stock Photos is a nice resource for finding, mostly black & white, historical photos.
- <u>US Government Graphics and Photos</u> Most of these images and graphics are available for use in the public domain, and they may be used and reproduced without permission or fee. Be sure to check the copyright of each image before commercial use.

- <u>Negative Space</u> is a beautifully curated collection of CCo-Licensed images for bloggers, artists, and small businesses. It has an easy-to-use search feature, and you can also browse images by tags and colors.
- Public Domain Pictures offers free high-quality images, graphics, and vectors for downloads.
 Images are sorted into categories for easy browsing.
- As the name suggests, New Old Stock features a beautiful collection of vintage photographs that are now in the public domain.
- My Stock Photos has a decent collection of hundreds of free stock images for blogs. Images are neatly organized in categories and can be downloaded in high resolution.
- Pickup Image offers a huge collection of public domain images. The site can be easily browsed through tags, or you can try the search. It also offers free clipart and graphics.
- SplitShire is a beautiful collection of photographs released under the CCo-License. You can browse the site by using tags, filters, or view images in the mosaic view.
- The Flickr account of The British Library showcases over a million illustrations, drawings, and works taken from 17th, 18th, and 19th-century books. All these works are released under the CCo-License and can be used anywhere without restriction.
- LibreShot features the works of photographer Martin Vorel released under the public domain.
- <u>PDPics</u> is a collection of free public domain stock photos. And it has a large collection of thousands of public domain images you can download and use in your blog posts.
- Reusable Art is a collection of thousands of vintage drawings, illustrations, and artworks. All works
 displayed on the website are under the public domain.
- Skitterphoto is a beautifully-curated collection of CCo-Licensed images. The site features works of their own photographers, so you will find less-used and unique photographs.
- StockSnap is a curation of beautiful free stock photos where hundreds of images are added weekly
- <u>Barn Images</u> is a collection of CCo-Licensed images. You can browse images in categories or tags, or you can search for keywords. All images are available in high resolution for free downloads.
- Taken by <u>Karolina Grabowska</u> from Poland, this beautiful collection includes great fashion and food stock photos. Copyrights: free of restrictions do as you wish, but when possible Karolina kindly asks to give credit to the website
- <u>Gratisography</u> Truly unique. Usually whimsy ;) Always free. <u>PEACE OF MIND LICENSE</u> without copyright restrictions
- <u>Life of Pix</u> A beautifully curated collection of free stock images by Leeroy, an advertising agency in Montreal. Any photographer can submit photos, but only superb ones are selected to be featured. Free of restrictions.
- <u>Startup Stock Photos</u> These photos are awesome if you need to create or design websites for startups and entrepreneurs. free of restrictions do as you wish (they would appreciate linking to their website though)
- <u>Picjumbo</u> The website is an ad-funded website, so they kindly ask you to turn off your ad-blocker. They also have a premium option and even created a <u>Photoshop plugin</u>.

- StockSnap A great-looking collection of high-res free stock photos from around the web
- New Old Stock Vintage photos from public archives recapturing history. Free of known copyright restrictions.
- <u>Picography</u> This is a small hand-picked collection of photos taken by professional photographers. Free of restrictions
- <u>Albumarium</u> You can browse through super-niche categories (called Albums) such as "Smokers" or "Blondes". Photographers can upload their own photos, and anyone can create a new album.
- <u>VisualHunt</u> VisualHunt uses the Flickr API and searches Creative Commons photos.
