 - It's unlikely, but if we have at least a 45% participation rate, we can receive an additional 5% back

Funding Requests

- RCI requested funds toward the 6th grade end-of-year field trip to Chula Vista in WI Dells.
 This was a time-sensitive request so the Board approved \$350 toward the cost of the buses.
- Request from NKE Kindergarten
 - As part of their end-of-the-year A to Z countdown, the kindergarten classes used to visit the public library. Now that the library is not walkable from NKE anymore, the kindergarten teachers wonder if we can cover the cost of the bus to the new library building. Cost: approximately \$100-130

Vote to approve up to \$150 – passed unanimously.

- Request from PVE 3rd Grade
 - On May 31, PVE 3rd graders will go to McKee Farms Park for a picnic and then to the Madison Children's Museum. They are requesting help paying for the bus. Cost: approximately \$200-250

Vote to approve up to \$275 – passed unanimously.
