\$50 + \$30 per additional character

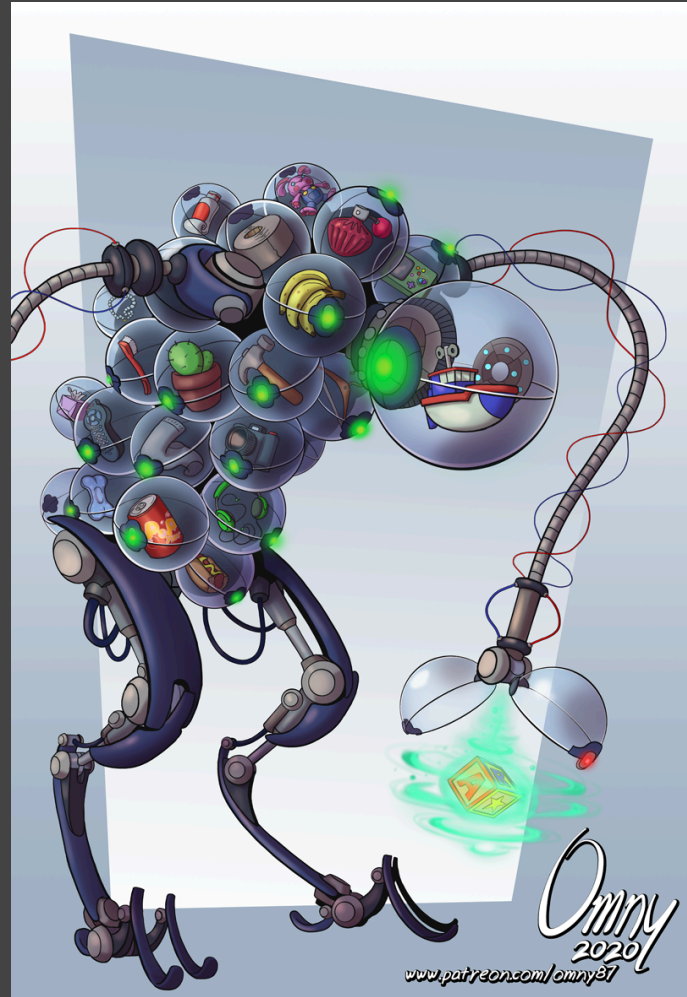


Color + Cel Shading

\$100 + \$80 per additional character

Comic Page

Sketch: \$100 per page, + \$50 per add. character

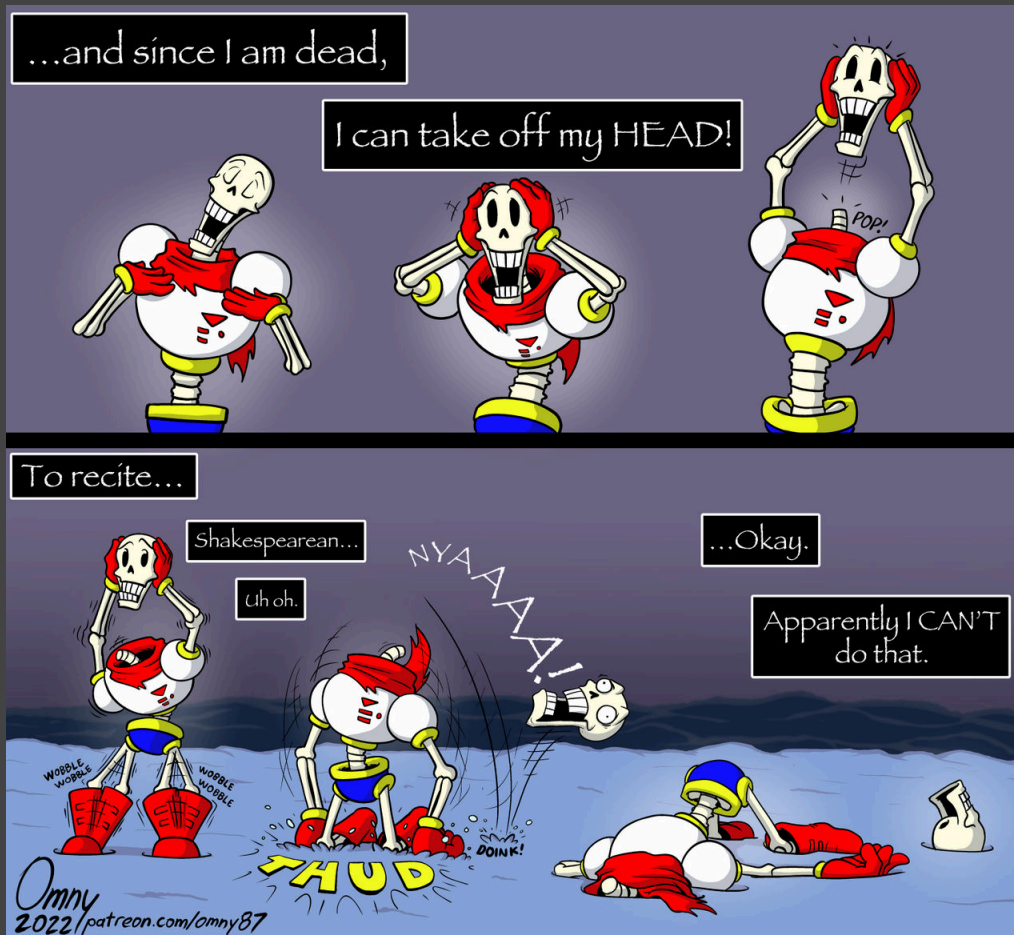
Ink: \$200 per page, + \$100 per add. character

Cel Color: \$300 per page, + \$150 per add. character

Soft Color: \$400 per page, \$200 per add. Character

(Additional character prices are added to **the whole comic**, not per page.)

Mini-Comics: Comic pages that are only 2-3 panels long are **half price**.



Note: a single "page" is a somewhat arbitrary measurement in this case, but in general it's a self-contained comic or chapter of a comic between 4-8 panels long, depending on how the panels are laid out (usually if they're able to comfortably fit on a single sheet of paper, or if a separate page would fit the pacing better). Just give me a detailed script on how the comic should go, and I'll work out the panel layout myself.

"Splash Pages", I.E. Pages consisting of one big panel are the same price as a comic page only if they're a direct continuation/introduction of a comic page, that is, if they're part of a series of more than one page. Otherwise, they'd be the same as a regular non-comic commission picture. Splash pages can include one or two smaller side panels.

Adding Backgrounds

+\$30 and over, depending on level of complexity (a simple meadow, empty room, a brick wall, or a cloudy backdrop will be much cheaper than complex cityscapes, looming space stations, cluttered antique stores, or massive mountain vistas).

Backgrounds will otherwise be left blank, transparent, or given a simple gradient.

Descriptions and Payment

Once you've claimed your slot, just [e-mail me](mailto:omny_commissions@yahoo.com) at omny_commissions@yahoo.com with a description of what you'd like me to draw. Descriptions can be as detailed as you'd like- you can even just give me a brief summary of what you want and I'll let my imagination do the rest. Reference pictures for characters and other details are appreciated, but not required.

Once you and I have settled on what you want, I'll send you a PayPal invoice for you to pay (think of it as a digital bill of sale).

Don't worry: **You don't need a PayPal account** to pay a PayPal invoice!

Rules Regarding Commissions

Payment is cash only. I will not take payment in the form of DeviantART Points, Steam gifts, cryptocurrency, gift cards, favors, trades, or anything other than money via **Paypal**. Non-U.S. money is fine, so long as it is able to be transferred through Paypal.

Regarding Upgrades on Old Commissions: If you, for example, pay for a sketch commission and decide to upgrade it to a higher-tier picture a week or a month later (ink, color, background, etc), you only need to pay the difference between them (Patreon discounts still apply).

Regarding "additional" characters: when requesting a piece with more than one character, said characters must be interacting with each other or at least interacting with the same environment, not simply standing next to one another. If your commission consists of a single character with multiple forms/identities (werewolves, superheroes, shapeshifters, etc.) they don't need to be interacting.

Characters who are low-detail or obscured (silhouettes, shadows, speech balloons from off-screen, stuffed in a bag, etc.) don't count as "characters" and don't add to the price, due to them being simpler to produce.

Large, indistinct crowds of characters (shoppers at a mall, stadium/concert audiences, angry mobs, zombie hordes, marching soldiers, a flock of dragons, etc) are considered **backgrounds** rather than characters for the sake of simplicity.

Some examples of interaction include, but are not limited to:

Talking/arguing/whispering	Kissing/hugging
Holding hands	Surveying a battlefield
Staring lovingly at each other	Flying side-by-side through the sky
Glaring at each other	Sharing lunch
Preparing for battle	Playing a game together
Getting dressed in a locker room	Shooting at a horde of zombies
Looking for clues in a library	Reading the same book

Regarding Sexual/Violent Content: I'll draw most anything if asked, but even I have my personal limits. In general, if you want to know if I'm willing to draw something, just be straight and honest about what you'd like me to draw and I'll tell you whether or not I'll draw it, no judgment.

You must be **18 or older** to receive artwork from me containing nudity or sexual content, or otherwise be of legal age to purchase adult content in your state/country.

<p><u>The most I'm willing to draw:</u></p> <p>Blood, gore, and general violence</p> <p>-</p> <p>Dark/disturbing themes (torture, monsters, death, etc)</p> <p>-</p> <p>General Nudity</p> <p>-</p> <p>Suggestive/risqué content (pinups, lewd posing, etc)</p> <p>-</p> <p>Most fetishes (again, just ask and I'll give you a simple yes or no)</p>	<p><u>I will not draw anything involving the following:</u></p> <p>Any fetishes involving pee and/or poop (using those in a comedic fashion is fine)</p> <p>-</p> <p>Underage (18 and under) characters in extremely violent and/or sexual situations. Absolutely <u>no exceptions</u>. This includes "aged-up" versions of underage characters (Ex: Fifi Le Fume from <i>Tiny Toons</i>; Bart from <i>The Simpsons</i>) and characters who are canonically over 18 but look like little children (Ex: Sasami from <i>Tenchi Muyo</i>; Babette from <i>Skyrim</i>).</p> <p>-</p> <p>Real people in risqué/violent situations without their express permission. For example: I will draw a sexy shirtless Deadpool, but I will not draw a sexy shirtless Ryan Reynolds.</p>

Nothing offensive or hateful. I will not draw anything for the purpose of mocking/insulting particular artists/creators, nor anything un-ironically racist, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, or otherwise promoting hatred and/or ridicule towards any individual person or specific group, nor anything that advocates real-life hate groups (I.E., a character dressed like a Nazi is fine; a character endorsing/praising Nazis is not, unless they are obviously in the wrong). Again, if you're unsure, just ask.

Regarding Commercial Use and/or Further Edits: Once you've received a completed commission from me and you've paid in full, you may not sell it as your own art, but you can use it for commercial purposes (logos, album covers, book covers, etc) as long as you give me proper credit doing so.

Please let me know ahead of time that you wish to use your commission for a commercial endeavor or a logo for some project of yours- I'm not asking for royalties, I simply don't want to accidentally cry "art theft" when I see my art on a bookshelf or website somewhere. Plus, I like to see what other people do with my art!

In addition, if you wish to pay another artist to ink and/or color my art, or if you want to do so yourself, you may do so (send me a link if you wish, too!).

You may not sell, commercialize, ink, color, re-color, or otherwise edit any art you yourself didn't pay for without the client's permission!

Regarding Anonymity: If you don't want your commission displayed for whatever reason, like if you're commissioning a gift for someone or it's just very personal, let me know ahead of time and I will not post it. I'll simply send you the image file for you to download yourself. If you want your commission posted, but you wish to remain anonymous for whatever reason, I will not put your name in the commission slot list or in the picture description.

Finally, **tips and donations** are not required, but are totally acceptable!
