



## **COURT WATCH MONTGOMERY BOARD OF DIRECTORS RESPONSIBILITIES**

***MISSION: Court Watch Montgomery reduces intimate partner violence in Maryland by ensuring victims have access to responsive justice and vital services that can stop the abuse quickly and permanently.***

### **Responsibilities of the Board of Directors**

- Define the organization's mission and vision, updating as necessary.
- Develop long and short-range planning to carry out the mission.
- Provide fiduciary oversight necessary to achieve the mission.
- Ensure the organization follows all federal, state, and local laws and adheres to its mission.
- Recruit, orient, and develop board members.
- Hire an executive director, provide oversight, and annually evaluate the executive director's performance.
- Abide by the established bylaws of the organization.
- Establish policies for the effective management of the organization.

### **Responsibilities of Individual Directors**

- Understand and promote the organization's mission.
- Participate actively in decision-making, exercising best judgment.
- Become a working member of at least one board committee or task force.
- Participate in resource development and fundraising activities.
- Make an annual gift to the organization significant according to individual circumstances, so that Court Watch Montgomery can seek outside funding based on 100% board participation. Minimum amount is currently \$1,000 per year, through direct donation or fundraising.
- Advocate and educate on behalf of the organization.
- Review board meeting materials and attend board meetings, committee meetings, and special events.
- Review and approve the annual budget and IRS Form 990.
- Follow the Conflict of Interest policy.
- Help to identify and assist in cultivating potential institutional and individual donors.

### **Anticipated Time Commitment**

- Serve at least one complete three-year term.
- Devote approximately 5 hours per month to CWM committees, task forces, special projects, fundraising, or monitoring.
