Tutors expect that you will...

- Be an active participant in the tutoring session.

- Be as specific as possible about what you are hoping to achieve in the tutoring session. Ask
 questions and listen to suggestions.
- Attempt your homework on your own before bringing it to a tutor to help; a tutor cannot do your work for you.
- Make sure to email your tutor if you have problems accessing the meeting.
- Only schedule a one-on-one tutoring meeting you know you can attend, and notify your tutor if you cannot attend.
- Within the tutoring session always conduct yourself in an appropriate manner. Our tutors are here
 to assist you academically. We have a strict "no-fraternization policy," sometimes known as
 no-dating policies.

Students can expect that tutors will...

• Be punctual, supportive, and professional

- Answer questions to the best of their abilities
- Work WITH you but not FOR you
- Be knowledgeable about other available resources to assist you
- Set clear expectations about the session and encourage you to be an independent learner
- Offer a positive attitude and be respectful of your diverse perspective and learning style
- NOT correct your homework, projects, take-home exams, or essays. They will provide useful comments and suggestions to help foster independent learning.
