



If you're enrolled in a high school class that earns **college credit**, you have access to a special **online tutoring service-Brainfuse**. Please read carefully to understand how it works:

Who Can Use the Tutoring Service?

Students taking college-credit (dual-credit) classes.

What Classes Are Covered?

The tutoring service is available **ONLY for your college-credit classes**.

Examples may include:

- College English
- College Algebra
- Other dual-credit courses

It is **NOT available** for regular high school classes

How Tutors Can Help

Tutors can help you:

- Understand course material
- Review difficult concepts
- Prepare for exams
- Improve writing assignments
- Work through challenging problems

What Tutors Cannot Help With

Tutors cannot help with:

- Regular high school classes
- Homework from non-college courses
- Tests or assignments outside your college-credit classes
