Weekly Update from Wycliffe 12/8/25:

Dear friends.

This week we worked on the consultant check of Ezra chapter 7. We will get our consultant's response soon. Again the main part of our work was to revise chapters of Exodus. The translators revised Exodus 19:1-20:17. Kitchu was able to work ahead and has worked through Exodus 17 adding her comments. I was able to check through the work the translators did on Ezra 7 and Exodus 19:1-20:5. I checked changes the translators made, added comments to give suggestions and make corrections. A big part of my time is spent on translating the verses from Avokaya back into English. I had less time to work on Avokaya this week because of medical appointments.

This week I had five medical appointments, two physical therapy sessions for my hands. and three other check up type sessions. I was encouraged by the results of my eye appointment. My retina is healthy. The potential for glaucoma is still there, but there has not been a change in that issue this year. My main issue is dry eyes, for which I can use eye drops or hot compresses.

Next week will also be a challenge for me to keep up with the work the translators do. The small groups I am involved in will have their Christmas meetings. I have the final two physical therapy sessions, and will need to get my car serviced. There is an official two week break for Christmas and New Year. I am sure I can catch up during that time.

This week I was able to successfully send money to the translators to help them with school fees and rent. Praise God for that.
