Please know that students currently seated at our MYP Partnership schools, The Brawley School and Oakwood Middle School, automatically qualify for this program and need not complete the application process. If you attend another school and would like to apply for this scholars' track, please review the following information.

MISSION:

The mission of SIHS is to challenge students to develop as self-confident, lifelong learners who are ethical, globally-minded, critical thinkers. The goal of the MYP is to prepare students for the academic rigor of the IB Diploma and Career-Related Programmes offered in grades 11-12.

MYP AT SIHS:

- consists of eight subject groups: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics, Performing and Visual Arts, Physical and Health Education, and Design
- seeks to provide a framework of high academic expectations
- encourage students to understand connections between course content and the real world
- embraces international mindedness while developing respect and appreciation for other cultures
- requires that students complete Service as Action experiences each year as part of the curriculum
- requires that students complete the Personal Project, an independent, significant, exploratory design project, in year 5 (10th grade)

- Students must be in good academic and disciplinary standing.
