- 3. Advocate for a better health care system.
- 4. Collaborate with national and /or community partners

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicants: Dental medical school students or dental interns
- 2. Applicants must provide a cover letter identifying their motivation
- 3. Applicants must provide a project proposal (Please find the project proposal document attached)
- 4. English, French, and Arabic are accepted.
- 5. Research projects are accepted.
- 6. Group projects are encouraged
- 7. projects that already started could be funded if they obey

Applications of those already enrolled in the "Fundamentals of Dental Public Health" training program will be prioritized.
