Soul Coherence Studio - Faith Chiang, founder

Soul Coherence Studio is launching <u>The Soul School</u> early next year - an emergent learning community for people committed to soul-centric living and experiential learning.

Our core premise: **Soul Work IS World Work.** Through "**Souling**" **Technologies** (ancient practices updated for our time), we're learning to work generatively with the light and dark in ourselves, unlocking creative power through embodied practices, ritual, and relational inquiry.

The Soul School offers rhythmically-attuned gatherings - daily Morning Musing, biweekly Soul Circlings and monthly Soul Seminary workshop series – where we co-shape the curriculum through the art of inquiry. We will also hold seasonal events like Soul Journeying for the collective good, and run year-long soul initiation/descent programs.

Room 1: EMUNAH ΛCΛDEMY — Ganga Devi Braun

EMUNAH ACADEMY of Multidimensional Living is a living ecosystem for personal and collective transformation. Our work sits at the intersection of the somatic, the sexual, the spiritual, and the systemic offering practical frameworks and embodied practices that help our students reclaim their life force, restore relational integrity, and align with their deeper values. We integrate trauma-informed wisdom, nervous system intelligence, and regenerative principles to support individuals and communities in bridging personal healing with collective evolution. Our frameworks are rooted in both deep theoretical study and direct experience, designed to be practiced in real life, in real relationships, and in real time.

We are currently offering <u>the EDGE</u>, a deep-dive course into embodied sexual energy as a source of power, presence, and purpose. We are preparing to launch *BeginWithin 2026*, a year-long container for those ready to live the transformation they seek. Accessible,

community-oriented, and multidimensionally integrative, *Begin Within* will support participants in harmonizing the internal, interpersonal, intergenerational, and institutional aspects of life. In an age of compounding crisis, we believe this work is essential not as personal escape, but as collective emergence.

Room 3: Resilience Relief and Recovery Reach, Inc. (R4) — Jessica Maness

R4 strengthens disaster response through community-led coordination and open-source tools like WNC-Supply-Sites, R4D2, and R-Link, helping neighbors meet real needs quickly and transparently. We avoid cookie-cutter solutions by listening to survivors first and ensuring communities have the tools and support they need to rebuild long after the crisis. Upcoming initiatives include a unified Community App for everyday resilience and Stepping Stones, which brings disaster-response speed and dignity to ending homelessness.

Room 1: Beyond Goals Intensive — Teresa Hart, Benjamin Carr, Sarah McManus

The <u>Beyond Goals Intensive</u> is a 5hr online workshop that uses live coaching, focused coworking, and structured activities to help people feel clearer and more aligned in their life. We've run these workshops 60 times in the last 9 years, helping over 2000 participants connect with what matters most, shape meaningful goals, clarify their path, integrate blocks, and find flow.

Our course curriculum weaves tools for pragmatic action within a coherence and embodiment-oriented approach to cultivating internal alignment. As a participant you will leave with a customized ecosystem of practices, systems and rhythms that will support you in living your life as it unfolds. Our annual New Years workshops on Jan 3, 4, 10 and 11 are run on a pay-what-you-want model (with a \$35 deposit). We invite you to come and take the workshop and then decide how much you want to contribute based on the value you received! Self-Organization for complex times through Collective Leadership.

Leadership³ combines pragmatic methodology with cultural transformation to enable self-directed teams, agile decision-making, and sustainable resource stewardship towards a regenerative world. Our integral approach addresses three essential levels: personal mastery and authentic self-leadership, effective team collaboration with transparent roles and intelligent meeting design, and systemic consciousness for global challenges. Beyond metrics lies culture change: when people lead from their authentic capacity within evolving structures, they bring their wholeness to work. Leadership³ supports evolutionary organization where complexity

becomes navigable through conscious design, adaptive systems, and deep human trust. We explore and cultivate the competencies and cultures needed for leadership's future – and a regenerative world.

Room 3: Metachrysalis — Daniel Lindenberger



Metachrysalis is a real-world cooperative game and living framework that helps people and organizations collaborate toward regenerative futures. It bridges play, purpose, and praxis—turning the overwhelming complexity of the metacrisis into a metachrysalis: a stage of collective transformation where new systems can emerge. Through story, systems thinking, and open-source tools, participants ("players") discover allies, map their gifts and roles, and take meaningful, right-sized actions that strengthen their bioregions. The approach engages all eight forms of permaculture capital and reframes regenerative work as joyful, relational, and deeply grounded in place.

Each Metachrysalis session guides participants through a gameful process of orientation, character creation, exploring localized dynamics, and co-designing real-world quests. It supports bioregional regeneration, collective sensemaking, and mutual empowerment across contexts—from long-term transformation to resilience building and rapid relief. Emerging from Daniel Lindenberger's *Mycelial Approaches to the Metacrisis* fellowship and early pilots in Vancouver, Langley, and Milwaukee, Metachrysalis is now expanding across multiple regions. The initiative is stewarded by Thaumazo, a Canadian nonprofit supporting the people and projects using this framework to regenerate their places and relationships.
