IS School Enrollment & Attendance Policy

- 1. **Request for enrollment** (or resume classes from an extended leave by filling in <u>registration form</u>)
 - ➤ Class will start as soon as possible, but may take up to two weeks or longer depending on teacher availability

2. Rule regarding overall attendance %


- The IS school expect students to **maintain 65% average attendance** during an active enrollment (schedule requested start to end date)
- ➤ If % goes below 65%, one will be removed from the schedule
- ➤ Inform us about the leave through email, whatsapp, or coming to the office link, minimum 24 hours in advance.
 - i. If **3x absences in a row without communication, one will be removed** from the schedule.
- > Extended leave requests:
 - i. If absence or leave more than 4x in a row, it must be requested 2 weeks in advance!
 - IF requested less than TWO WEEKS, those absences will affect your overall attendance % score
 - ii. Leaves LONGER than 2 weeks, may require a schedule/group change and are therefore considered a withdrawal from the program.
 - Message us directly, or send a registration form again when you are ready to resume your classes after a leave of two weeks or longer.


3. Self Assessment
