What is a Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison?

A Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison is a member of the community who voluntarily facilitates school registration and community acclimation for new, non-English speaking families. A Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison needs to be able to communicate in both English and their native language. A Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison can be anyone who has a student in K-12 here in Weymouth, and/or has a child who has graduated. Roles of the Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison can include but are not limited to:

- 1. Assisting in the school registration process
- 2. Assisting the family to communicate any additional support they may need and interpret information to/from the school on such topics.
- 3. Guiding families into their new community
- 4. Connecting families and children to others in the community

At this time, the Parent/Guardian/Caregiver Liaison positions are voluntary. But, it offers wonderful opportunities and rewards. The Weymouth school community would greatly appreciate your efforts in this!
