If you plan on selling the recording or putting recordings behind a paywall, we need to specifically talk about the conditions and compensation upfront so that we can have a copyright transfer contract.

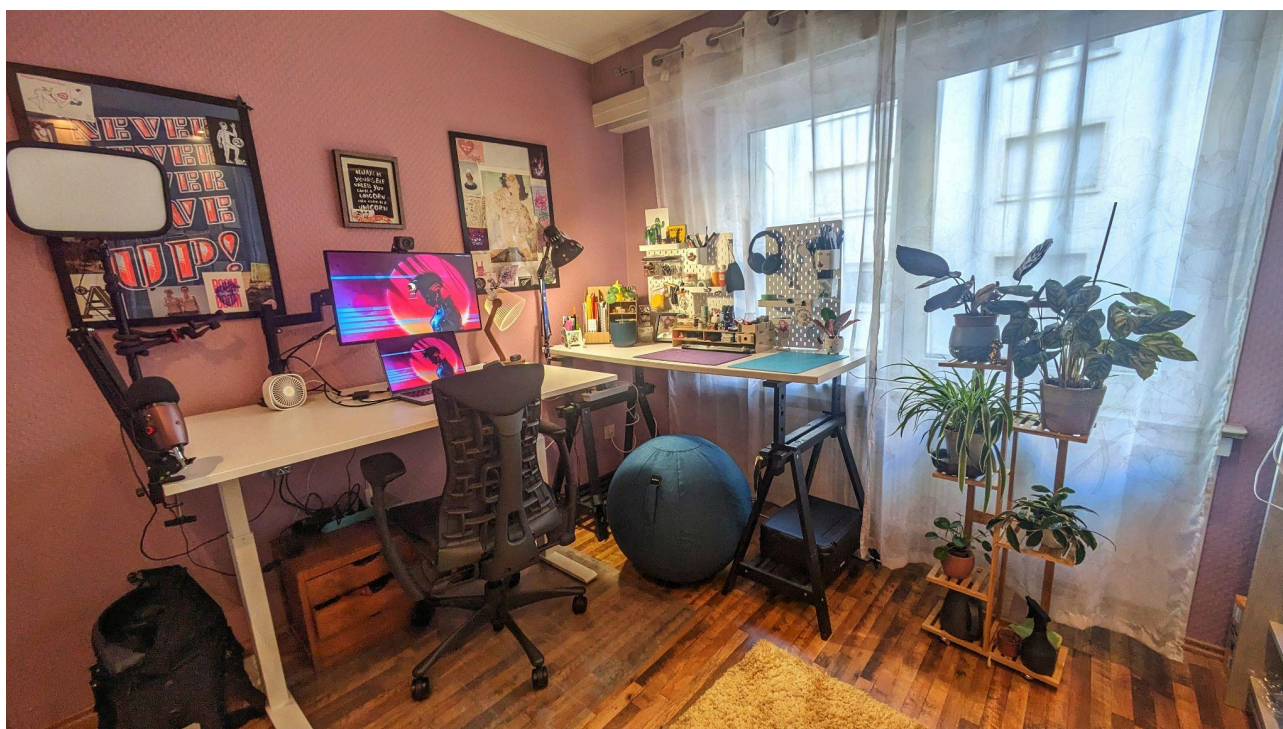
