
For PLDI Artifact Authors

- 1. First, create a zenodo account: https://zenodo.org/ if you don't have one yet.
- 2. Once you log in, click "Upload" at the top of the zenodo home page.



3. Now, you should be able to upload your artifact by clicking "New upload".



- 4. You need to fill in some basic information before you click "Publish" at the bottom. Ideally, would make your artifact publicly available immediately and permanently; if you decide against this, please choose "Restricted Access" for the Access right
 - a. Note that once your artifact is uploaded, it can never be deleted; in other words, it's permanent. By using "Restricted Access", your upload will only be accessible to people who you grant access to in the PLDI AE process, that will be the AEC members.
 - b. However, you can still update your artifact after you upload it. Essentially, you can use zenodo as a version control tool. This will make the AE process easier, since the AEC could use the timestamps to track the latest version before a given deadline (especially given the AEC may request modifications from authors during the AE process).
- Once you publish your artifact, it will generate a DOI. Please include the "Target URL" in your artifact submission. Please submit a link to an exact version of the artifact, NOT the latest version.
- 6. Immediately after the artifact submission deadline, the AE members will start requesting access. Please closely monitor your emails, as those requests will get sent via emails.
- 7. Please accept the request immediately upon receiving them, which should all come from pldi.ae.zenodo@gmail.com

8.	AEC members might request modifications to artifacts from authors during the AE process. These requests will be through the HotCRP system via emails. Authors should upload the latest version of the artifact to the same zenodo repo and let the AEC know once that's done. The AEC members will then evaluate the latest version on zenodo.
