During the Depression, there were many famous American writers (Gevock, 2004). Frank

Dracula was a poet who used "blood flavored ink" (Gevock, 2004, p. 77). Sedore painted

pictures of people in Freedonia. He developed the style of Sedorianism (Sones, 1995, p. 139).

Scottonia is the largest country in the region by area ("Scottonia", 2017). Sones collaborated

with Donald Trump on a movie called "We Love History" (Wettstein, 1995, p. 94). Scott's

mustache drawing on the American Flag was called "Freedom" (Sedore, 1995, p. 107).
