

Parent Forum Q&A:

- Questions about class size: Most of the Cohort D classroom are at full capacity. Currently, there are no classes with 27 students in it.
- Dismissals and Tardies: If your child is going to be late to class or needs to leave early for the day, please email both the classroom teachers and your homeschool's secretary.
- Seesaw: Yes, your classroom teachers will give you instructions on how to access Seesaw and there will be information on our Cohort D Family Website.
- A website is in the making. Please give us at least week to get it up and running.
- Unfortunately, due to ELL and IEP services, lunches/recess/break times cannot be streamlined cross grade. Just like in in-person school, grade levels often have different lunch times.
- Frontloading K: Students in K do have academics throughout the. Similar to lunch and breaks, academics are also staggered so that IEP and ELL minutes can be covered.
- We are working with K teachers to lessen the amount of log-ins per day. Please email us if there is still an issue next week.
- Question-if I feel like my second grader is having a hard time and needs to go to school some days, can I switch? Unfortunately, not at this time.

- .Websites: Teachers will not have individual websites, just their individual Google Classrooms where all information can be found.

- Is the Wednesday schedule posted somewhere? Wednesday schedules will come from individual teachers.
- Just to clarify all the specials are pre-recorded? Yes.
- I appreciate all the hard work that was put into this. I wonder if there will be a regular cadence to the communication from you both and/or teachers so that we have a clear sense of what is happening and when things will be coming up? Judy and I are working on the website and creating a plan on regular communication.
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- You are all still part of your home schools-Principals will be sharing the same information with all families no matter the cohort.
- We are unclear about how snow days will look for Cohort D. We are still waiting on information from District Level administrators.
- The district would prefer all families use the technology issued to them. That being said, if you can access using an easier method, please feel free to do so.
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
