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| Required: 26.5 credits total 100 volunteer hours The following specific classes | Literature- 4.5 credits Classical Literature (9) European Literature (10) US Literature (11) Modern Literature or AP Literature (12) Rhetoric (semester class) or AP Language (year-long) (generally 11) | History- 4.5 credits Western Civilizations I (9) Western Civilizations II (10) US History or AP US History (generally 11) Modern History or AP European History (generally 12) US Government (generally 11) |
| Science- 3 credits Biology or AP Biology (9 or 10) Chemistry (9 or 10) Physics or AP Physics (11) | Mathematics- 4 credits Four years of mathematics (Note that Foundations of Mathematics counts as an elective course, not a math course) | Foreign Languages- 3 credits Three years of Spanish or Latin in high school or successful completion of the AP level or foreign language credits through BYU/an accredited program |
| Physical Education- 1 credit -0.5 credit semester-long PE and Strength and Conditioning courses -0.25 credit for each sport you play for a whole season | Singleton Requirements- 1.5 credits 0.5 credit Health 0.5 credit Personal Finance 0.5 credit Technology (Information Technology, Programming, Publishing, or Digital Art)* | Fine Arts- 2 credits Options including Symphonic Band, Jazz Band, Chamber Orchestra, Advanced Choir, Theater, Foundations of Art, Drawing, Painting, Digital Art, Ceramics, Music Theory, and Publishing* |

*Note that a single semester of Publishing or Digital Art can count as either Technology or Fine Arts, but not both.
