**Introduction:** Thank you for participating in this study. This work is affiliated with the UBC course "Advanced Methods for Human Computer Interaction" (CPSC 444). Please note that we are seeking participants over the age of 19. (Ideal participants should have some familiarity with donating, but you are not required to donate to be participants.)

**Purpose:** The overall purpose of this research is to design a personalized, engaging donation experience to motivate donor behaviour.

What you will be asked to do: After you have read this document, I/we will respond to any questions or concerns that you may have. Once you have signed this consent form, you will be asked to:

- interact with a prototype web interface while the computer screen is being video recorded
- participate in a short post-study interview where your responses may be audio recorded.

This should take about 30 minutes and be completed in one session.

The sessions may also be video and/or audio recorded. You have the option not to be video/audio recorded.

**How the data collected will be used:** Data collected (including any audio/video recordings) will be used for analysis and may also be used for class project presentations and other research presentations. Although only a course project in its current form, this project may, at a later date, be extended by one or more of the student investigators to form the basis of their thesis research and/or be submitted as a research publication.

**Compensation:** There is no compensation for participating in this study.

**Confidentiality:** The results of your participation will be reported without any reference to you specifically. All information that you provide will be stored in Canada. It will be treated confidentially and your identity will not be revealed in reporting the study results. The two exceptions are: (1) excerpts from the video/audio recording in which a participant can be identified may be presented in a class project presentation (but any other presentation venue, such as a scholarly conference, will require that participants be non-identifiable in the video/images), and (2) we request but cannot enforce focus group members to keep discussions from any focus group confidential.

**Data Retention:** Identifiable data and video/audio recordings will be stored securely in a locked metal cabinet or in a password protected computer account. All data from individual participants will be coded so that their anonymity will be protected in any reports, research papers, thesis documents, and presentations that result from this work.
