@Maya: Isabel, to resolve MS db Heroku password_hash field 500 error, I directly alter the characters limit on pgadmin. I posted it on <u>zulip</u>.

@Isabel: Can't we use a migration script to do that?

@Maya: Unfortunately we can't since password_hash is not the field we created through db.create() because it is not specified as one of the fields in the Users db model (it is created by JWT and by default elephantsql assigned 100 characters as the limit). But in our code we allow users to choose between 8-64 characters for password and we also use SHA256 which means the password hash will vary so we shouldn't use a specific limit.


@Vaishnavi: we can use Poetry to manage Python dependency as was used in MS backend repo.

@Maya: would love to implement the same at BIT. Will wait until the MS backend PR on poetry gets approved and merged to see how it works.



@Maya: had resolved conflict on <u>pr 1074</u> for BIT-MS first integration step - users schema extension with BIT attributes

@Isabel: will check and merge it. ZoneInfo for Timezone can be open as a separate issue later down the track. BIT-MS integration is the main priority.

@Maya: will open an issue on BIT backend to refactor Timezone to zoneinfo. But will put it on hold and open for contributors to work on once the BIT is fully integrated to MS.

@Aditya: I also created an excel using github API to list contributors pr during OSH. It gets the data from the PRs with label OSH

@Maya: not all PRs have labels since we normally only label the issue. But will label them asap for the purpose of this OSH and will let Aditya know once it's done so he can refresh the list.

@Aditya: contributors could be frustrated with the long time taken from when pr was submitted to finally merged.

@Maya: Need more maintainers on the project since atm I'm the only maintainer so there's limited bandwidth (balancing Open Source, life, and study). The review process also takes sometimes since the pr has to be approved by 2 people, tested then merged.

@Isabel: Any suggestions on who can be added to BIT maintainer?

@Maya: Aditya and Vaishnavi have helped a lot in the backend. But they already take the position as MS Backend. Rahul and Jalal have helped a lot on frontend, so we can ask them if they would like to be added to the BIT Maintainers. ACTION ITEM

OSH

@Maya: There is a confusion on frontend <u>issue 168</u> on who can be classified as `First-timer`, whether contributors to be considered as `First-timer` at the start of OSH or as normal (never made contribution to the repository).

@Isabel: Yep, it is a snormal. Clarified it on the issue with this post

BIT Backend to merge with Mentorship Backend

@Roshni: What is stopping us from having a deployed version. One of the issues Latest discussion on Mentorship System session

Issues of supporting current architecture:

 Lack of proper infrastructure to support microservices, since we're using a free tier version of Heroku. <u>Heroku won't allow for multiple servers to</u> <u>connect there with free tier</u>

SQL lite vs Postgres

@Aditya: Stem diverse TV faced some issues because they used sql locally and postgre for production

@Maya: We have used Postgres, because SQLlite does not allow for multiple schemas. But if we agree to put BIT related tables in the same schema as MS, we don't need to keep 2 separate schemas anymore, then we can use SQLite for development and postgres for remote deployment (both with one schema only just like the current MS).

Features of MS & BIT: do they overlap? Are they common?

@Roshni: I think it's a good move. I felt in the beginning that BIT was an extension of MS. When we have people matching on, then they can use MS.

@Roshni: at the organization I am working for. The program is being run within the organization. If only used within the organization, they can use MS, if they want to open they can use BIT

@Aditya: I also had concerns about the setup. Would the setup be similar to MS or BIT?

@Maya: all this overhead will not be there if we agree to merge both schemas into one. It will be as easy as MS. There would be no need to set up postgres with 2 schemas for either BIT or MS.

@Isabel: I think this would help BIT and would not hurt MS. We may have to be careful with making this a phased integration.

@Vaishnavi: When we use the setup locally, we don't set up the DB credentials. Would we need this if we moved to MS?

@Maya: Once the BIT schema is integrated to MS, we would not need db credentials anymore since we'll be using sqlite as local db just like MS.

@Vaishnavi: Having both func will change the definition of MS?

@Isabel: I think FEs can be independent of BEs. We can have 1 BE, and use them for differente FEs where we combine functionalities in different ways.

@Maya: It's like an extension of MS, MS FE is for personal level mentoring, BIT FE is an organizational mentoring

@Vaishnavi: integration will lead to vanishing of BIT backend? as @aditya says duplication of code

@Isabel: I think BIT backend would vanish in this case, be archived, once fully migrated.

@Maya: Once MS Backend PR #1029 for BIT to MS integration is approved and merged, please push PR #22 to upstream "MS backend > bit branch" so other contributors can also help with the PR review and testing.

@Harsh: Ok, will do that.

@Aditya: can we setup docker for BIT backend to make it easy for new contributors to run backend (save them from having to setup locally which might be difficult to some.

@Vaishnavi: not many use docker as observed in ms-backend

@Aditya: on MS, probably that's because setting up locally not as difficult as setting up BIT since MS can use sqlite which will be created automatically when contributor run the application

- @Maya: the docker setup will not be easy especially in creating postgresql inside docker
- @Aditya: While setting up the postgres database, isn't there a way setting up using python?
 - @Maya: You are thinking of python migration? I attempted that but I faced some issues. it works only for initial db creation but if there is a change in db schemas, changes after initial migration still doesn't work.
 - @Aditya: Not the flask-migration, but the actual creation of postgresql database from inside python itself.
 - @Maya: Have you tried that before? I know we can create the db tables through flask-sqlalchemy, but the database postgresql must already be created first beforehand outside the python code. So flask-sqlalchemy inside python only to create the tables, not the database itself. I've never come across it on python, if you have resources, please do share so we can look into it
 - @Aditya: Never done it myself but will look for resources on it.
 - @Vaishnavi: I like using external commands bcoz through those I'm 100% sure the database is created
- @Rahul: I was thinking of options for deploying backend. https://www.pythonanywhere.com has a free plan and seems like an option.
 - @Harsh: I have used it. It's slow.
 - @Maya: will look into that if it can be an alternative solution to Heroku

FRONTEND

- @Vuyanzi: one problem with that is the wording is too long, it will be difficult to fit all inside that section. Will see what we can do to accommodate that without affecting the design.
- @Maya: If we are to put the whole story on the 1st image, the carrossel won't be needed anymore.


@Isabel:

- → Look at the meeting minutes from GSoC and see what work has not been put into issues, work left out for other priorities
- → Define coding standards (e.g.: Mentorship Backend coding standards)
- \rightarrow you can check your repo for places where these are failing and create issues for newcomers

- → Analyze your project setup and documentation and see what areas you can improve. Newcomers will be discouraged if they face many issues with setting up your project.
- → You should focus on getting people involved with your project through first timers only issues
- \rightarrow As a maintainer, define a roadmap to your project, and make it public on the stream and let people know about it
- → Create a GIF of the UI and put it in the README (show people that yoru project is already built, and they can add additional stuff to it)
- → Look at the missing tests for both backend and web, and create little issues for that

Places to show first timers only: #newcomers > First Timers Only stream.
