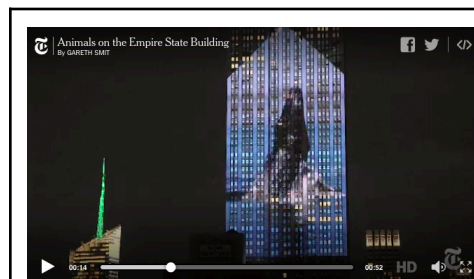
STEP TWO: Look at links below to gain understanding about why and how artists create art about endangered species. When you feel like you are ready to choose artworks to analyze, move to the next step.
