 - **Prince of Peace**: True peace found in God's presence.

6. Personal Application: The Presence of Immanuel

- Testimony of a chance encounter and a conversation about faith.
- Acknowledging feelings of distance from God.
- God's unchanging desire to be with humanity despite our shortcomings.

7. The Basis of Our Relationship with God: Grace

- The cost of the gift:
 - Jesus taking on flesh, entering the world humbly, dying on the cross, and rising again.
- God's pursuit of humanity and our invitation to surrender to His presence.

- Reassurance: God meets us where we are, even if we feel distant.
