MTSS Professional Learning Options for Schools

Schools may choose to obtain Professional Learning through online courses on the OPI Teacher Learning Hub, District and Building Implementation Team Modules via the OPI MTSS website, and/or through face-to-face learning. This will be dependent on the needs of the individual school and the current availability of course offerings. It is recommended that courses are taken sequentially. The MTSS Overview Course offered through the Teacher Learning Hub is a prerequisite.

Whether schools choose face-to-face learning or on-line courses (or a combination of both), supplemental professional learning will be necessary. OPI can assist you in developing an MTSS Professional Learning Plan for your school through the MTSS Information Line on the MTSS homepage.

CSPDs' offerings must be requested in advance. Contact your regional CSPD coordinator to schedule. Professional learning through CSPDs will be dependent on funding and need within a region.
