Dave Bailey: brought up the sign on the Triangle, "We Love Our Children" that was originally purchased by the Mannix Family in memory of their mother. This sign has been stolen twice. The association has repurchased this sign. Now there are locks on the sign.

Andrew Keough: brought up that he has lived here for decades and he feels the chemicals that are being used on lawns as fertilizer and weed killer is hurting the sea life. He has asked all to please limit or eliminate what you use, or try to use organic. Nitrogen is going into the ocean and hurting. Also stated Sewer has helped.

Announcements

Deb Lezama: received letter from 3 residents of Bay St. regarding ownership of said road. Copies of this letter expressing a legal opinion were given to all in attendance. Talk of non-beach people using the beach. Tim Egan spoke that the original deed Roads/Avenues/Beaches are all owned by all owners. Talk of all roads are 40 feet wide, some places/homes have encroached on this. Deb emphasized that this is not a CBIA issue, but rather threatens all property owners of Crescent Beach. Jen Capobianco read a letter from Joseph Hiller 1961, stating the intention all property owners have access to all the roads and beaches as residents of this private community. This letter will be posted on the website.
