VILLAGE OF CHITTENANGO LOCAL LAW NO. D OF 2021

A LOCAL LAW PURSUANT TO CANNABIS LAW §131 OPTING OUT OF LICENSING AND ESTABLISHING RETAIL CANNABIS DISPENSARIES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CHITTENANGO

Be it enacted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Chittenango, as follows:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the New York State Constitution and New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10 and Cannabis Law §131.

SECTION 2. INTENT.

It is the intent of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Chittenango to opt the Village out of hosting retail cannabis dispensaries within its boundaries.

SECTION 3. LOCAL CANNABIS RETAIL DISPENSARY OPT-OUT.

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Chittenango, County of Madison, hereby opts-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries from locating and operating within the boundaries of the Village of Chittenango.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> <u>VALIDITY & SEVERABILITY.</u>

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Department of State. Pursuant to Cannabis Law §131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and thus may not be filed with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.
