

Nityavedika Privacy Policy

Effective Date: October 30, 2025

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy governs the use of the Nityavedika mobile application (the "Application"), a productivity tool designed for Notes, Tasks, Links, Calendar, Reader, Habits, Drawing, and Focus.

The Application is provided by Chintu (the "Developer").

We are deeply committed to user privacy. Our policy reflects the core principle that Nityavedika is an offline application that does not collect any personal information.

2. Information Collection and Storage

The Application is designed to function entirely offline, ensuring maximum user privacy.

A. No Personal Data is Collected

The Developer explicitly confirms that the Nityavedika application does not collect, store, transmit, or share any Personally Identifiable Information (PII).

PII includes, but is not limited to:

Names, email addresses, phone numbers, or physical addresses.

Precise location data.

User account identifiers (as there is no user account).

B. User Content (Notes, Tasks, etc.) is Stored Locally

Content Definition: All user-generated data, including Notes, Tasks, Links, Calendar entries, Habits data, Drawings, and Focus logs (collectively, "User Content") are stored only on the user's local device storage.

No Server Connection: User Content is never transmitted to any external server or third-party service by the Developer. The Developer has no access to, nor control over, this User Content.

Data Control: The user is solely responsible for managing, backing up, or deleting their User Content using the functions provided by the device's operating system.

3. Third-Party Services Disclosure

The Application relies only on essential software provided by the Android platform and Google for stability, not for data collection.

Google Play Services: The Application utilizes Google Play Services for platform functionality, such as checking the application license and managing updates. The data collected by these services is governed by Google's own Privacy Policy.

Analytics and Crash Reporting: We do not utilize third-party analytics software (like Firebase Analytics) or advertising. If the Application crashes, anonymous crash reports are

automatically generated by the Android operating system and sent to Google to help the Developer monitor stability. This data is purely technical and contains no Personal Data.

4. External App Interactions

The Application's features may interact with other applications on your device:

Calendar / Tasks: Features may interact with the device's native calendar/tasks application (e.g., Google Calendar) to display or save event reminders. Any data shared in this way is handled by your device and the third-party application, not by the Developer.

Links / Reader: When a user clicks a link, they are directed to an external browser. This Policy does not cover third-party websites.

5. Children's Privacy

Nityavedika is not directed at children under the age of 13, and since we do not collect any PII, we are not subject to the requirements of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).

However, we encourage parents and guardians to supervise their children's internet and mobile activities.
