Hotspot Connection Written Instructions:

- 1) Press the power button on the hotspot
- 2) Look on your Chromebook for a wifi network named something like Kajeet SmartSpot #####. Connect to it.
- 3) Look on the back of the hotspot for the sticker with Wi-Fi password on the sticker. Type that password in on your Chromebook. (If there is no sticker, see the help sheets links below to figure out what it is.)

Ideas to make the hotspot work better:

- The hotspot should be near a window maybe--somewhere that it can have a strong signal. It needs a minimum of 3 bars to work well.
- Sit with your Chromebook very near the hotspot. (If there is a microwave running nearby, it will cause problems, so stay away from those too.) You could also plug in the cord from the Chromebook to the hotspot if you want, but it is not required.
