Background Information	 What are H.86 & S.197 (Location Shield Act)? These bills would prohibit data brokers from selling, leasing, or trading people's cell phone location data without their explicit consent. This data can currently be purchased by almost anyone — including anti-abortion groups, stalkers, ICE, and private bounty hunters — without a warrant. Why these bills matter: The Location Shield Act would ban the sale and trade of cell phone location data. This will protect people who Come to MA to access abortions/reproductive healthcare that has been banned in their own states. Go to synagogues and other religious institutions. Frequent LGBTQ+ gathering places. Are trying to flee from domestic violence. Seek gender-affirming care 			

Status:

The bills were favorably reported out of the Joint Committee on Advanced Information Technology, the Internet and Cybersecurity. They need to move forward to the House Ways & Means Committee and then to the floor for a vote.

Ban the Sale of Cellphone Location Data (ACLU MA); specifically highlighting the dangers that this unregulated industry poses to the LGBTQ community (Mobilize/ACLU MA); and protecting everyone's individual privacy (JALSA in partnership with ACLU MA).

Maryland – "Maryland Online Data Privacy Act of 2024" (H.B. 567, signed May 2024)

Goes into effect: October 2025

- Strict ban on the sale of sensitive data including precise geolocation data, biometric data, sexual orientation, health data without the consumer's explicit consent.
 - Different from older "opt-out" models: it's an **opt-in** requirement for sensitive data.
 - Applies even if the consumer didn't explicitly ask to opt out: the default is don't sell.
- Applies specifically to data brokers and first-party controllers.
- Requires data minimization: companies can only collect, use, or store data that's reasonably necessary to provide the service.

What's unique:

- Moves from the CCPA-style "opt-out" to an opt-in standard for sensitive data.
- Applies data minimization broadly, not just to location data.
- One of the first comprehensive privacy laws on the East Coast that covers all consumers, not just residents who take action.



Oregon – Oregon Consumer Privacy Act (SB 619, signed July 2023)

Went into effect: July 1, 2025

- Covers sale of sensitive data, including precise geolocation.
 - Requires **opt-in consent** before collecting or selling sensitive data.
 - Consumers don't have to file a request to be protected.
- Defines "sensitive data" to include:
 - Precise geolocation data (location accurate to within ~1,750 feet)
 - Health, race, religious beliefs, sexual orientation, etc.
- Includes **right to delete, correct, or access data**, and requires data protection assessments.

What's unique:

- Explicitly includes opt-in consent for the collection and use of precise geolocation data — stronger than California, Virginia, and most earlier laws.
- Applies to many data brokers and regular businesses.
