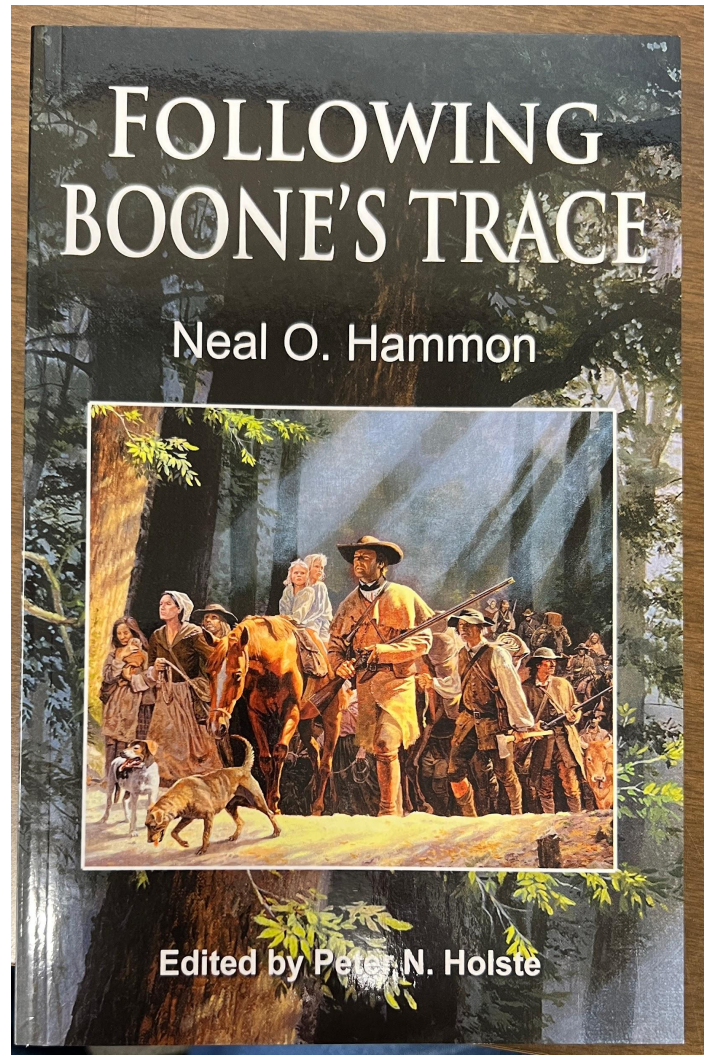


Following Boone's Trace
