



1. Click on Teacher




2. Click on Start now




3. You may need to sign in at this step if you are not already. Note: Students are not allowed to sign into ADS.


4. Click on either Browse curriculum or Browse our lessons.




5. Click into a lesson from the tiles on the screen.




6. Click on one of the videos






- Go to your course in Google Classroom at https://classroom.google.com
- 10. On the Classwork tab, click the Create button. Choose Assignment, Question, or Material based on what you plan to do with your lesson.




11. For whichever item you chose in Step 2, click Upload in your window. Find your video file and upload it to your course.



12. Browse for your file on your computer and upload.




13. You will see your video listed in your Assignment, Question, or Material after uploading.
