Automated External Defibrillators (AED) are life-saving devices intended to be used by a lay-person in the event of a cardiac episode, in addition to calling 911. Once opened, devices provide step-by-step audio instructions, but it is important to familiarize oneself with the function of the device ahead of an emergency. Review the Red Cross' 7 step-by-step instructions and training video (5 min).
