Important Information

Reminders:

- **Fees:** Fees **NEED to be paid in full by Monday, May 3rd**. This includes lunch fees. Everything must be paid in full. Use the Payschoolscentral.com. Payment plans available through our Central Office.
- **Credits:** You must have 21 credits to graduate and meet the ODE expectations for the Class of 2027.
- **Community Service Hours:** Complete 20 hours of Community Service Hours and record it in SchoolLinks prior to Graduation Practice in order to participate in the Graduation Ceremony.
- **Final Exams:** **Tues. May 4 th - Fri. May 7th**. Please follow the document that teachers have for exam exemptions if you are eligible. Final exam schedule will be released at the end of April.
- **Last Day of School:** Your last day of school is **Mon. May 3rd**.

Graduation Practice:

- **Location:** Franklin High School Main Gym
- **Date:** **Wednesday, May 12th**
- **Time:** **9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.**
- **Attendance:** **Attendance is mandatory in order to be able to walk during graduation.** Students will be required to sign in and out for attendance purposes.
- **Community Service Hours** will be verified - if not completed, you will not have a seat at graduation
- **Transportation:** Seniors will arrange transportation.

Graduation Day:

- **Location:** UD Arena - *1801 S Edwin C Moses Blvd, Dayton*
- **Date:** **Sunday, May 16th**
- **Time:** **2:00 p.m.**
- **Arrival Time:** **12:45 p.m.**
- **Expectations:** Graduation is a rich tradition for Franklin High School. Graduation will be classy, elegant, and traditional. Please behave appropriately with a sense of pride and honor.
- **Attire:** Wear attire that is classy, elegant, and traditional:
 - Boys may wear a dress shirt, dark or khaki pants and dark shoes.
 - Girls may wear a white or light colored dress (no patterns or prints on the dress). Light dress pants are okay. Shoes should be light colored high heels, flats, or platform sandals.
 - **No jeans, no tennis shoes.**
- **Behavior:** Make smart decisions. You are almost there. Let's not have an unfortunate situation that would keep you from graduating.
- **Personal Items:** There is no safe place to store your personal items during the ceremony. Leave all valuables, including keys with family, friends, or at home. Cell phones are not permitted during the ceremony. All cell phones need to be silenced or turned off.
- **Parking:** Students, parents/guardians, family, friends, and guests will park at UD Arena.
- **Seating:** Seating at UD Arena is first come/first serve basis. Reserving seats is not permitted.
- **Tickets:** You do not need a ticket to be admitted. All guests are welcome.

- **Safety and Security:** There will be an Emergency Medical Service Team onsite as well as Law Enforcement Officers circulating throughout the Commencement Ceremony. They will also be available before and after the ceremony to help with traffic safety.

Important Check In/Check Out information on Graduation Day:

- You will be given your check in location before graduation practice. This is the check-in location you will report to for practice and on graduation day.

Graduation Day guidelines for Graduates, Parents, and Guests:

- You may NOT decorate your cap. This is a college tradition.
- No silly string, confetti, beach balls, etc...
- No loud noise makers, air horns, etc...
- No booing or making fun of another person or graduate.

Please adhere to the expectations. These items could be a safety hazard and require additional clean-up for our staff.
