You should NOT sign up for this course if you:


- ★ Don't like loud noises (this course will be loud...)

Do you love tabletop games?


The Dungeons & Dragons roleplaying game is about storytelling in worlds of swords and sorcery.

- Exploring engineering and "maker" culture in the Bay Area




