Responsible for the cutting down of rotten and dead trees. Required to use tools of the trade for pruning and related maintenance activities such as handsaws, pruning hooks, shears, chainsaws, hand clippers and hedge cutters. Ensure that personal safety procedures are adhered to correctly and the appropriate safety equipment is worn at all times as per standard operating procedures.
