## 3-Ingredient Slime Recipe



## **Ingredients:**

- GLUE: 2 (4-ounce) bottles washable school glue, such as Elmer's (see note for variations)
- **BAKING SODA:** 1 teaspoon baking soda
- SALINE SOLUTION: 2 to 3 tablespoons saline solution (e.g., contact lens solution)

## **Optional ingredients:**

- 1 to 2 drops liquid food coloring
- 1/4 cup glitter

## **Slime Facts:**

Slime is both a liquid and a solid! Slime is a non-Newtonian fluid, which means its viscosity, or flow, changes when force is applied to it.

Toy slime was invented in 1976! It was sold in plastic trash cans by Mattel.

There are lots of different recipes for making slime. Slime can be made with household items like glue, borax, water, shaving cream, cornstarch, contact solution, and more! Children (and adults!) may enjoy experimenting with different slime recipes to see how the consistency changes.
