



CITIZENSHIP REFORM ACT 2020

Earl Jack of Molrams makes the following regulations and reforms in the exercise of the powers conferred by decree of the Constitution.

1. **The following tiers of citizenship shall be recognised and implemented by the Parliament of Essexia, and specifically the Ministry of the Interior (MoI):**
 - a. Category One citizens shall be those individuals who have applied to the MoI and have been accepted as citizens of Essexia, and who have joined the Discord server. They are eligible to vote in Discord and Public elections, appear on the national census and use Digital Yen.
 - b. Category Two citizens shall be those individuals who have applied to the MoI and have been accepted as citizens of Essexia. They are eligible to vote in Public elections, and appear on the national census.
 - c. Category Three citizens shall be those individuals who follow Essexian social media. They are eligible to vote in Public elections.
 - d. Category Four citizens shall be those individuals who act as foreign diplomats to Essexia, but have not applied to the MoI nor follow Essexian social media.
2. **The Ministry of the Interior (MoI) may decide to tax certain citizens of Essexia.**
 - a. The MoI may only implement taxes on category one and/or category two citizens.
 - b. Bills regarding the implementation and removal of taxation must be passed through Parliament.
 - i. Should the bill in question proceed through Parliament and become legislation, the Ministry of the Interior shall be responsible for enforcing the taxation in question, and the Ministry of the Treasury shall be responsible for suitably keeping and using the taxation in question.

- 3. The Ministry of the Treasury (MoT) shall be responsible for collecting and managing the taxes owed by the relevant citizens of Essexia as directed by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Essexia.**
- a. It shall be the duty of the MoT to handle the taxes finances of these citizens responsibly and legally.
 - b. The MoT shall carry out all taxation requested by Parliament and the MoI.
- 4. Taxation shall be collected in any currency deemed fit by the relevant Act, or the Ministry of the Treasury.**
- a. Should a citizen attempt to pay taxation in a currency that is not deemed fit by the relevant Act or MoT, they are liable to be prosecuted as a defendant by the Ministry of Justice (MoJ).
 - b. Should a citizen refuse to pay taxation, the MoT may seize the assets of that citizen equal to the amount due, with the consent of the MoJ.
 - i. These assets shall not be required to be in a form of currency deemed fit by the relevant Act.
 - ii. These assets shall not be in the form of British pound sterling (£).
 - c. Should a citizen be unable to pay taxation, it shall be the responsibility of the MoI to either find a compromise with the citizen, or, with consent from the MoI, the MoJ may prosecute the citizen as a defendant.
