Look toward the Monastery Lake to see the riverbank examples. Most are pictures of the Po River in Italy because there are similarities between this real world river and our CDS River Rhenus. The Po is a long river in the north of that country. The city of Turin is one of the urban areas that border the river. The Po is also the only Italian river to have a delta area. The banks of the Po and many other Mediterranean rivers are grass-covered. Short trees and bushes populate these banks in some places. In addition there is an abundance of wildlife including many bird species with flamingos, egrets, wigeons, and grebes among them. Deer and pheasants roam the banks, and sometimes horses as well as smaller mammals. Migratory songbirds can also be found there. Below are some photo examples that were used as models to build our inworld samples.

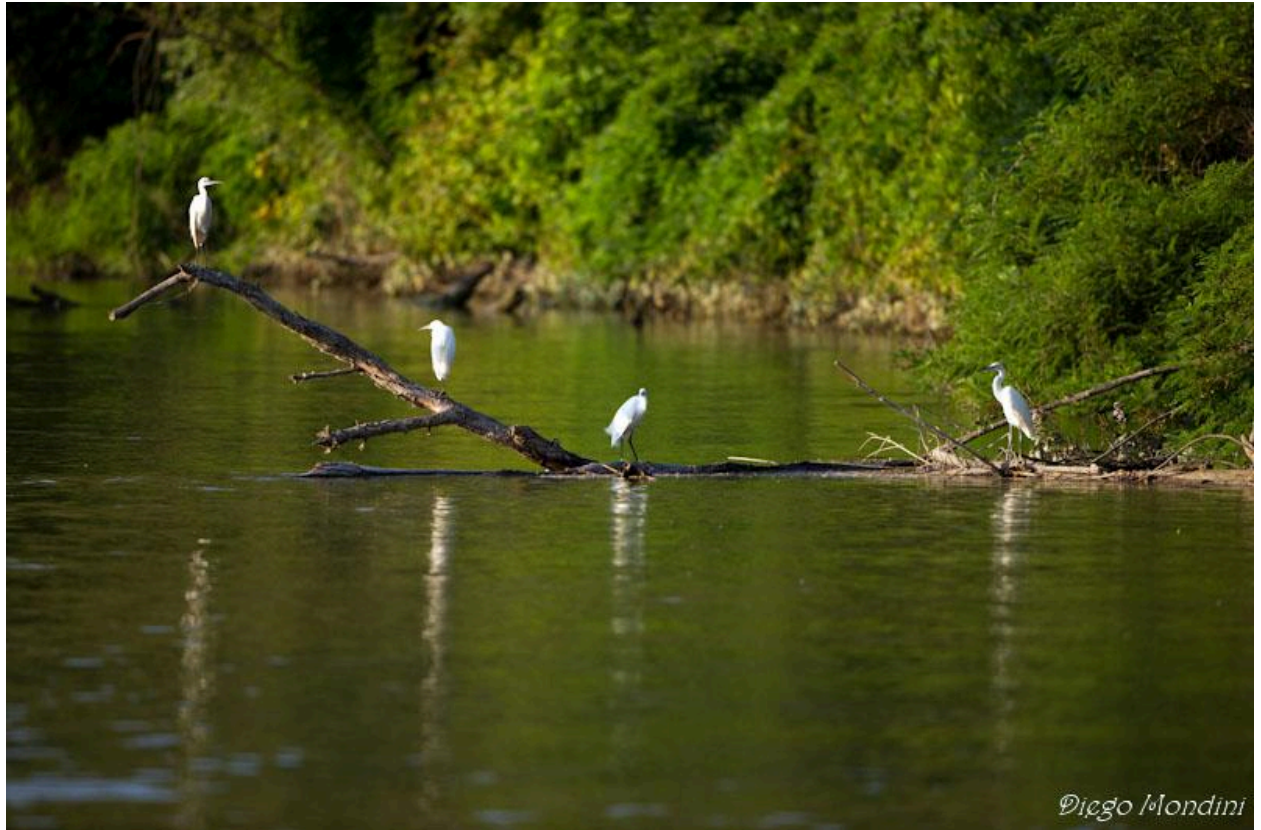
