Course outline:

Module 1: Getting Ready – focus on all letters from a-z, initial, middle and final sounds

- ✓ Overview of how Phonics can help children to read and spell
- ✓ Importance of parents' participation in supporting their children to learn phonics
- ✓ Sounds of all 26 letters in English

Module 2: Combining letters into words – focus on the various approaches to help children blend words that do not involve changes of sounds

- ✓ Understand how oral blending and segmenting can prepare kids to read and spell
- ✓ Learn to build 3-letter words through rhymes and Letterland stories
- ✓ Practise blending CVC words that do not involve changes of sounds
- ✓ Examine the sounds of various consonant blends and word endings such as 'bl', 'cl', 'gl', 'br', 'cr', 'pr', 'ck', 'ss', 'nt' etc

Module 3: Spelling Workshop – focus on strategies and tips to help kids read and spell decodable words (CVC, CCVC and CVCC)

- ✓ Explore tools and activities that can help with blending and spelling
- ✓ Practise CVC, CCVC and CVCC words in Cambridge Starter wordlist and other lists
- ✓ Suggest early reading strategies and the choice of suitable reading books

Module 4: Exploring sounds of digraphs 1 – focus on the change of sounds of some major spelling patterns

- ✓ Learn digraphs such as 'ch', 'sh', 'th' through Letterland stories
- ✓ Examine short and long vowel sounds with the Letterland's way
- ✓ Practise identifying various long vowel spelling patterns

Module 5: Exploring sounds of digraphs 2 – focus on the change of sounds of more spelling patterns

- ✓ Examine the sounds of 'r' controlled vowels, 'w' controlled vowels, and others common spelling patterns
- ✓ Examine some common spelling anomalies
- ✓ Practise checking pronunciation from dictionaries

Module 6: Practise-it-yourself workshop – focus on practice in word building, syllabication and stress

- ✓ Practise spelling words for Cambridge Exam and Primary vocabulary
- ✓ Introduce the concepts of syllabication and stress

✓ Move from sounds to grammar and meaning
